Exam Scheme:

- Computer Based Test: A computer based test will be conducted for all the candidates who are successful in the physical efficiency and measurement test, information about which will be published separately in newspapers/websites.
- The question paper of Computer Based Test (CBT) will be of 150 marks,
- In which there will be 150 objective type questions.
- And the time duration will be 2 hours.
- 01 mark will be given for each question answered correctly. If a wrong answer is given, 25% of the marks prescribed for the question will be deducted.
- This examination will be online computer based.
